**April meeting**. We held our Annual General Meeting where our committee were reelected, minutes and accounts were agreed and a general discussion followed about recruiting new members and the insurance for the club. The National Sugarart Association, to whom we are affiliated and pay £55, arrange the insurance and this year the cost had soared to more than the income from the club membership. They are currently negotiating with the insurance firm to get a reduction (see later in newsletter). The AGM was followed by a short demonstration on Spring Gonks. 15 people renewed their membership and hopefully a few more will be joining this month. Our numbers are much lower than in previous years but at the moment we are in a good position financially due to a lot of fundraising. However, we have to be aware that with out this we would not be financially viable and would not be able to pay for demonstrators every month as they are charging more plus travelling expenses.

**May Meeting.** We had booked Georgie Godbold for this month but unfortunately she is not demonstrating at the moment as she has problems with her hand. Jan Fergusson has very kindly agreed to show us enamelling. This is a very pretty effect, another sugarcraft technique we have not seen before. Please come to the Tollgate Hall as the main hall is out of action. Same address, just the hall in the corner of the smaller carpark.

She will try to get some entry tickets for anyone who is going to the show and can spare a couple of hours to help. Alternatively hotels in Coventry and Kennilworth are not far away and there is a very good train service from Tile Hill and Coventry to the N.E.C. Stratford upon Avon and Leamington Spa are nice places to visit if you make a long weekend visit.

There are some sugarcraft shows coming up and also zoom demonstrations organised by British Sugarcraft Guild areas so it is always worth checking their site for events. Most are open to non members. They also have weekend skills workshops.
